- I. Mayor Kathy Carter called the meeting order at 6:30 p.m.
Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance
The invocation was given by Police Chief Paul Robertson and the pledge was recited by the Mayor, Council and Citizens in attendance.
- II. Announcements - Mayor Carter announced the lineup for the Christmas Parade would be at 6:30 PM and start at Matt's and would leave around 7:00PM. The parade route would be from Frisco Street to the school. The Mayor announced the Police Chief would lead the parade to the new gym and the Grand Marshal would be Lydia Anderwall.
- III. Consent Agenda
Cody Talley moved to approve the consent agenda. Doug Simmerman seconded, the motion passed 4-0.
- V. New Business
 - A) Alderman Kristin Thompson was sworn in.
 - B) Doug Simmerman made a motion to nominate Cody Talley as Mayor Pro Tem, Betty McCarter Seconded the motion, motion passed 3-0.
- VI. Reports
 - A) Police Department
Paul Robertson stated there were 239 total citations issued in November with 372 traffic stops, 277 calls for service, 1 crash worked, 7 offense reports, and 5 arrests.
 - B) Maintenance Department
Mayor and Council discussed the Lift Station at M & R Drive. Discussion was made on repairs versus new lift station. City Attorney, Cynthia Humphries discussed this was a 1 and a half year process to get started and then another 6 to 8 months to build a new station. City Attorney Cynthia Humphries discussed the act of trying to get a truck and look at all options of pump waste from the lift station and she also discussed an emergency loan and possible loan forgiveness grant due to the lift station needing to be larger due to the use of the school and its growing population in student body. No action was taken at this time.
