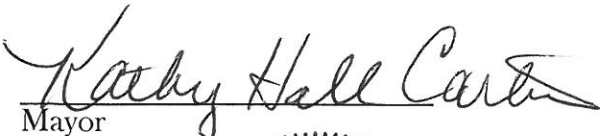


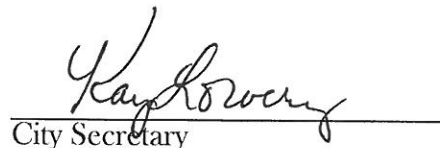
Regular Meeting Minutes of the City Council of the City of Cumby

- I. Mayor Kathy Carter called the meeting order at 6:30 p.m.  
Invocation And Pledge Of Allegiance

- IV. Consent Agenda

  - A) Jackie Holley moved to increase the pay for the Mayor to \$150.00 and for the council to 75.00 per month with the commencement dates on the positions as the law allows. Cody Talley seconded, the motion passed 3-0.
  - B) Cody Talley moved to approve Ordinance 2017-12-001 authorizing signature authorities for bank accounts listed in Appendix A of the ordinance to Kathy Hall Carter, Cody Talley, Jackie Holley and Kay Lowery. Robert Hines seconded, the motion passed 3-0.
- VI. Reports
  - A) Police Department  
Paul Robertson stated there were 293 total citations issued in November with 34 calls for service, 3 vehicle accidents, 7 offense reports and 14 arrests.
  - B) Maintenance Department  
Johnny Carter submitted a report for November with water leaks were repaired, sewer lines blown out, Christmas decorations were being put up and a 5.465 water loss.
  - C) Fire Department  
Chief Heath McCraw submitted a report for the month of November with 9 grass fires, 3 car fires, 2 structure fires, 7 medical calls, 3 motor vehicle accidents with 1 call in the city and 15 calls in the county.
