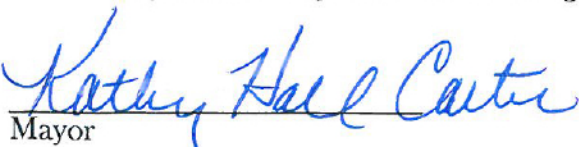


Regular Meeting Minutes of the City Council of the City of Cumby
Friday, September 28, 2018

- I. Mayor Kathy Carter called the meeting order at 6:30 p.m.
Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance
The invocation was given by Mr. Jackie Holley and the pledge was recited by the Mayor, Council and Citizens in attendance.
- II. Announcements – Mayor Carter announced the kickoff for the football game between Cumby and Detroit. Kickoff will be at 7:30 p.m. tonight at the Cumby ISD field. The Mayor also announced that the City tax rate would remain the same as last year due to required scheduling not being met.
- III. Presentations were made by citizens. Kyle Pettit recommended a facebook page and a suggestion box for the city as well as better transparency of the funds. Johnene addressed the Council about the utility rates and the budget. Tammy White also spoke about the property tax rate and about requesting copies
- IV. Consent Agenda
Jackie Holley moved to approve the consent agenda. Robert Hines seconded, the motion passed 5-0.
- V. New Business
A) Jackie Holley moved to accept the 2018-2019 Annual Budget as presented. Robert Hines seconded, the motion passed 5-0.
- VI. Reports
 - A) Police Department
Paul Robertson stated there were 289 total citations issued in August with 322 calls for service, 105 warning citations, 3 crashes worked, 3 incident reports, 5 offense reports, 5 CPS cases and 5 arrests.
 - B) Maintenance Department
Johnny Carter submitted a report for August with a 6.84 water loss, the new paddlewheel has been installed, both generators given to the city in 2010 by Hopkins County have been repaired and are now working.
 - C) Fire Department
Monty Lackey read the report submitted for the month of August with 3 calls in the city, 21 in the county, 7 grass fires, 2 car fires, 1 structure fire, 8 medical calls, 8 motor vehicle accidents and 74.90 manhours. Also reported was the ISO rating for the city was down to 4 from 18 which will reduce insurance rates for the citizens, Mr. Lackey urged the citizens to contact their insurance companies. There is a substation of the Cumby Fire Department in Brashear and the fire truck are housed at the water department. The Fire Department will be holding a motorcycle ride on October 6th to raise funds for the department.
