

ORDINANCE 99-1

An Ordinance providing for and approving the extension of the cable television franchise in the City of Cumby (the "City") granted pursuant to Ordinance No. 84-1, dated February 7, 1984 (the "Franchise Ordinance"); amending the Franchise Ordinance in certain respects; providing for publication of the caption and providing for severability.

WHEREAS, by the Franchise Ordinance, the City has granted to Friendship Cable of Texas, Inc., ("Friendship") as assignee of Galaxy Cablevision, L.P., the right, among other things, to operate a cable television facility within the municipal boundaries of the City; and

WHEREAS, Friendship has requested that the City approve the renewal of the Franchise Ordinance to February 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, City has requested that the franchise fee be amended from 3% to 5%;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANCHISING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY:

The City hereby consents to the extension of the Franchise Ordinance for a term of fifteen (15) years from its current expiration of February 7, 1999. The Franchise Ordinance will now expire on February 7, 2014.

Effective April 9, 1999, the franchise fee shall be amended from 3% to 5% of gross subscription receipts.

There are no other amendments and all other terms and provisions of the Franchise Ordinance shall continue and remain in full force and effect.

The City Secretary/Clerk is hereby directed to publish the caption of this Ordinance at least once in an official newspaper in the City, as authorized by statutes.
